This sample letter is a Word document and easy to modify. You will find some places (in track changes) where you must make a choice or insert something. Imagine a world where you tremble when you go up and down stairs. You cover your ears at the thought of a loud noise. Going through the car wash causes an anxiety attack. You buy your clothes based on the way they feel, not their style.

Strange as these reactions may sound, the reality is that this *is* the world for at least 1 in every 20 children. These are children with Sensory Processing Disorder (SPD), a complex disorder of the brain that affects the way information from the senses (sight, sound, taste, smell, touch, and movement) is experienced and turned into behavior. More than three million people are affected by SPD in the United States alone – an average of one child in every classroom. My child is one of these children/My clients are among these children, and that's why I'm writing you.

The STAR Institute is the heart of SPD research, education, and advocacy worldwide. I am trying to help STAR help children and adults with this disabling condition by raising funds to advance their work. Will you help me help?
